NOTES:

1. The determination of sewer is based upon metered water.
2. A special rate for the Kent County Sanitary Commission is 1.5 x in-town rate by separate agreement
3. Commercial haulers shall pay \$8.80/M gallons or part thereof.
4. Multiple apartments or trailers on the same water meter pay a minimum water and sewer charge for each apartment of trailer.

* The Town collects for the State of Maryland \$15.00 per quarter for the Bay Fund

** The Town collects for the State of Maryland a Bay Fund fee based on Water Usage.

* To calculate over 10,000 gallons use the following formula:

If a property uses 12,000 gallons then...

$$\text{\$2.83} \times 2,000 = 5,660.00$$

$$\text{\$5,660.00} \div 1,000 = 5.66$$

$$\text{\$32.00 (min)} + \text{\$5.66 (2,000 gal.)} = \text{\$37.66 for 12,000 gallons}$$

$$\text{\$37.66 (water)} + \text{\$37.66 (sewer)} + \text{\$15.00 (bay fee)} = \text{\$90.32 total bill}$$

* To calculate Bay Restoration Fee for Commercials, use the following formula:

If the property uses 47,000 gallons, then....

$$47,000 \div 90 = 52.22$$

$$52.22 \div 250 = 2.088$$

$$2.088 \times 15.00 = \text{\$31.32 Bay Fee for 47,000 gallons}$$

$$\text{(x by \$15.00 for 3Qs, x by \$10.00 for 2Qs, x by \$5.00 for 1Q)}$$

* Residential with 4 minimums x 10,000 gallons = 40,000 gallons per quarter is their minimum. Anything over 40,000 is charged per 1,000. (same for Commercial)
