

**UTILITIES COMMISSION MEETING  
FEBRUARY 17, 2010**

Mayor Bailey called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. In attendance were Council members James R. Gatto, Mauritz Stetson, Gibson Anthony and Mabel Mumford-Pautz, W.S. Ingersoll, Town Manager and Zoning Administrator, Jennifer Mulligan, Stenographer, and guests.

Mayor Bailey asked if there were any additions or corrections to the Utilities Commission meeting of January 25, 2010. **Mrs. Mumford-Pautz moved to approve the minutes as presented, was seconded by Mr. Stetson and carried unanimously.**

Mayor Bailey stated that cash on hand and in banks was \$403,915.46.

Mr. Sipes stated that new meters and a new meter reading system was installed. He said that the Utilities Department had been trained on the new equipment and knew how it worked.

Mr. Sipes stated that the UV bulbs were ordered and he verified that they were the right size. He said that when the bulbs were replaced he would turn over the old bulbs to Mr. Jon Hanley to be properly recycled.


Mr. Sipes stated that he thought he might buy a plow for one of the utilities trucks because when enough snow falls, it was difficult to get shoveled out. He said that they had to call Bramble in with this snowstorm because the snowdrifts were up around 6'.

Mr. Sipes stated that a manhole collapsed on South Cross Street. He said that the manhole was not in use anymore and the steel frame and cover was removed and it was filled with stone and cement. Mr. Sipes stated that it would be blacktopped when the weather improved.

Mr. Sipes stated that he would not know all of the repercussions from the snow until it melted. He said that as of right now, the manhole collapse was the only problem.

There being no further business, **Mrs. Mumford-Pautz moved to pay the bills as presented, was seconded by Mr. Stetson and carried unanimously.**
