Said motion was seconded by Mr. Rogers and duly carried.

After discussion Mr. Rogers made motion that our Solicitor be requested to draft a new ordinance incorporating all previous ordinances concerning restricted parking areas and one way streets.. years business at the end of the year. Unanimously agreed upon.
