The Mayor and Council met in regular session with all members present: Mayor Wilmer, Councilmen Rogers, Wheatley, Kendall and Moyer.

Minutes of the June meeting were read and approved. Also the financial statement.

Mr. Richard Schaubert, representing the Chestertown Brick Plant was present for the opening of bids of proposed street work. After discussion Mr. Wheatley made a motion that the bid submitted by Mr. Schaubert be accepted provided said work was completed by August 1, 1940, weather permitting, if not completed the penalty to be \$10.00 per day. Said motion was seconded by Dr. Moyer and carried.

With reference to sewer connections at the property of The Water Board and M. E. Capel Mr. Rogers made a motion that the Water Board put in septic tank for their own use. Motion seconded by Dr. Moyer and carried.

The report of recent census shows a decrease of 62 persons as compared with 1930. 1940 - 2747; 1930 2809. Mayor and Councilmen are of the opinion same is fair and hereby accept same.

Mayor Wilmer reported the need of a new flag for the Town. Mr. Rogers was appointed to purchase same.

A Building permit was requested by Leonard Houston to build an annex to his present building. Same investigated.

After reports of investigation and in view of facts stated in petition, Mr. Kendall recommended permit be granted provided all Town Ordinances be complied with in regard to connecting to sanitary sewer, flue lined chimney, and fire proof roof. Dr. Moyer recommended permit be refused because no material specifications were filed with plan and due to conditions found at the time of his investigation. By a majority vote petition to build granted.

Petition made verbally by manager of Martha Burges^s to build an addition to present building. There were no plans or specifications filed, Dr. Moyer made a motion that same be rejected until Ordinances be complied with by filing plans and specifications for buildings. Motion seconded by Mr. Rogers and carried.

Dr. Moyer reported requests to have weeds on lot of Sides and Brooks on Mt. Vernon Avenue mowed. Also complaint about weeds on lot of Kent County Savings Bank on Cannon Street formerly the Usilton property. Mayor to contact these property owners.

The audit for 1939 fiscal year presented and accepted.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
