The Mayor and Council met in regular session with all members present as follows: Mayor Wilmer, Councilmen Rogers, Wheatley, Kendall and Myoer.

Minutes of the May meeting were read and approved. Financial statement read and approved.

Deferred business: The three proposed street projects were reviewed and disposed of as follows: Proposed curb and gutter on the south side of mill street between High Street and Cannon Street approved and ordered. Proposed curb and gutter on Front Street and the proposed sidewalk on Spring Street left in the hands of Mayor Wilmer and the Street Committee to proceed.

Mayor Wilmer reported patch work on streets progressing and requested permission to order more slag. Motion that the Mayor order necessary slag was made by Mr. Rogers, seconded by Dr. Moyer and carried.

Dr. Moyer requested 'NO PARKING' signs be placed at the corner of the Telephone office restricting parking there and at the Voshell House corner. Motion was made, seconded and carried that Mayor Wilmer order said signs and have same placed. The request that an old truck be moved from the corner of High Street and Spring Avenue. Said truck believed to belong to the N. B. R. Motor Co.,

Mayor Wilmer to investigate same.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.

July 1, 1940

The Mayor and Council met in regular session with all members present: Mayor Wilmer, Councilmen Rogers, Wheatley, Kendall and Moyer.

Minutes of the June meeting were read and approved. Also the financial statement.

Mr. Richard Schaubert, representing the Chestertown Brick Plant was present for the opening of bids of proposed street work. After discussion Mr. Wheatley made a motion that the bid submitted by Mr. Schaubert be accepted provided said work was completed by August 1, 1940, weather permitting, if not completed the penalty to be \$10.00 per day. Said motion was seconded by Dr. Moyer and carried.

With reference to sewer connections at the property of The Water Board and M. E. Capel Mr. Rogers made a motion that the Water Board put in septic tank for their own use. Motion seconded by Dr. Moyer and carried.

The report of recent census shows a decrease of 62 persons as compared with 1930. 1940 - 2747; 1930 2809. Mayor and Councilmen are of the opinion same is fair and hereby accept same.

Mayor Wilmer reported the need of a new flag for the Town. Mr. Rogers was appointed to purchase same.

A Building permit was requested by Leonard Houston to build an annex to his present building. Same investigated.
