

April 7, 1941.

The Mayor and Council met in regular session with all members present as follows: Mayor Wilmer, Councilmen Rogers, Wheatley, Hadaway and Moyer.

Mayor Wilmer presented his certificate of oath of office then proceeded to take the oath from the two Councilmen, Mr. Rogers and Mr. Hadaway.

The minutes of the March meeting were read and approved, also the financial statement.

Motion was made by Mr. Rogers that the Mayor's appointments be ratified and confirmed. Motion seconded by Dr. Moyer and carried.

Deferred business: The question of proposed sidewalk on Spring Avenue ~~referred~~ to Street Committee. Sealed bids on Police Car. Mayor Wilmer reported he had in hand four sealed bids which he suggested being rejected and returned unopened to bidders. In view of certain facts Mayor Wilmer suggested the Council increase Mr. Cooper's salary \$1.00 per week to defray gasoline expense to his personal car used for Town work. Mr. Wheatley

made a motion that the Mayor's suggestions be accepted, motion seconded by Mr. Rogers and carried.

Mayor Wilmer suggested to the Street Committee the following improvement for immediate consideration: Improved road bed on Kent Circle from Washington Avenue to High Street. This being approved Mayor requested to let bids from Amiesite Company on same.

Report of Wards: Second, Mr Wheatley mentioned drain for sidewalk on Cannon Street between Mill and Kent Streets. Third: Mr. Hadaway requested action against speeding on West end of High Street.

Auditors report for 1940 presented and accepted. Motion by Mr. Wheatley, seconded by Mr. Rogers it be published in part, the same as last year's report, carried.

On motion the meeting adjourned.
