The following bills were presented and ordered paid:

Electric Light and Power Co., Sewerage Plant \$23.80, Parking Lot \$1.25, Traffic Light, \$1.76, Town Clock \$2.80, Quaker Neck Sewerage Plant, \$15.75.

Stam Drug Co., I Cash Book \$2.75

Coopers Hardware Store, I Bucket .30, I Sponge .29, I Hook and Eye .06.

The names of the following men for Supervisors of Election were presented by Mayor Wilmer; Mr. Laurence Brown, Supervisor of Election, and Mr. Leonard Needles, Clerk. Motion was made and seconded that these men be appointed.

Auditors; Mr. Don Falls and Mr. Arthur Cooper. This motion was moved and seconded and passed.

Mr. Hudson's estimate on the new Lighting System was put before the Mayor and Council. It was moved and seconded that the lights be installed, with the agreement that the Water Board pay one-half of the cost. The full amount being \$110.30.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
