

March 3, 1941

The Mayor and Council met in regular session with the following members present: Mayor Wilmer, Councilmen Rogers, Wheatley, and Moyer. Mr. Kendall being absent on account of illness.

The minutes of the February 3 regular and February 13 special meeting were read and approved.

The regular procedure of business was deferred on account of the members of the Water Board and others were waiting to be heard.

Mayor Wilmer received from Seantor Price an approved copy of the Bill presented for passage in reference to the changing of the date of the Town Election from March to December. He then asked Mr. Rogers to read and review with both boards a proposed Bill for the consolidation of the Mayor and Council and the Water Board. The Water Board unanimously approved the newly drawn Bill. Mr. Smith, Supt. spoke in reference to the Water Board employing consulting engineers for the purpose of making a survey to eliminate troubles with sand and iron corrosion, in their system. After discussion the Mayor and Council approved the plan for the Water Board to proceed to get estimates from engineers for the survey and preliminary ~~work,~~ work,

Mr. T. D. Bowers and Robert Moffett came before the Council representing 79 taxpayers of the Town and Mr. Bowers, spokesman emphatically demanded that the Mayor and Council immediately proceed with condemnation proceedings against Mr. Eliason to obtain right of way over his Spring Avenue property in order that the Town could proceed with the sidewalk from the archway to the Post Office. After discussion Mr. Bowers presented a petition and requested the Council take action. When they retired Mr. Rogers made a motion that

Special Meeting.

The Mayor and Council met in Special Session for the purpose of passing on the new budget and proposed bill for the changing of the Town election date from March to December. All members were present: Mayor Wilmer, Councilmen Rogers, Wheatley Kendall and Moyer.

Mayor Wilmer reviewed the proposed budget of income and expenses estimated on a 70¢ rate. Motion was made by Mr. Wheatley that the proposed budget be accepted at the rate of 70¢ which motion was seconded by Mr. Rogers and carried. Copy of budget attached hereto.

A bill for the purpose of **changing** the **Town Election** date from March to December so the newly elected officials could make their own budget rather than one passed on by the other board, was discussed. Motion was made by Mr. Rogers that the proposed bill be approved and authorized the Mayor to forward same to be passed. Motion was duly seconded by Mr. Wheatley and unanimously carried.
