Brooks House and also requested an ordinance be drawn prohibiting tractors with cleats from use of improved streets in Town. He also spoke in reference to High School students racing cars up and down the Avenue backfiring same.

Motion was made by Dr. Moyer that our attorney prepare an ordinance prohibiting use of tractors with spikes or cleats on the improved streets of Town, seconded by Mr. Hadaway and carried.

Correspondence from Salisbury in reference to having a princess from Chestertown at their Strawberry Celebration was referred to Mayor Wilmer for his action.

On motion the meeting adjourned.
