There were quite a number of complaints about stray dogs running at large over the Town, after some discussion Dr. Moyer made a motion that a letter be wrote to the Court Commissioners about same, seconded by Mr. Wheatley and carried.

Mr. Salloway appeared before the Council and the contract for the collection was discussed.

Mayor Wilmer stated that a notice had been put in the paper asking for bids to be opened for a new contract on Monday night February 12.

Mr. Mench one of the Teamsters sat in the meeting with us. He stated that he wanted to place a bid on the Contract.
