Mayor Wilmer reported that he had tried to get the auditors and had not been successful, Mrs. Crow could do the same after March 15th, 1945.

The budget was then presented and after looking over same, a motion was made by Mr. Wheatley and seconded by Mr. Rogers to accept the budget as presented at the same rate of \$.65 per 100.00.

The Mayor then read a report from the State road for repairs to some work, it was motioned to table same and get others to report.

Mayor Wilmer then made his appointments which stood as of last year.

There were quite a number of complaints about stray dogs running at large over the Town, after some discussion Dr. Moyer made a motion that a letter be wrote to the Court Commissioners about same, seconded by Mr. Wheatley and carried.

Mr. Calloway appeared before the Council and the contract for the collection was discussed.

Mayor Wilmer stated that a notice had been put in the paper asking for bids to be opened for a new contract on Monday night February 12.
