After some discussion it was made a motion by Mr. Rogers seconded Mr. Wheatley that we have a special meeting without pay on Monday night September 10th at 7.30 o'clock to open the bids for the Contract. A copy be sent to both men and ask for a written bid. This bid to include the sweeping of the streets also removal from the Hospital at no extra cost.

Mr. Sidney Turner appeared before the meeting in reference to the sewer proposal. After presenting a copy of the digraham drawn by our Engineer Mr. Metcalfe Mr. Turner agreed to sign same.

A motion was made by Mr. Rogers seconded by Mr. Wheatley that we accept the offer made by Mr. Turner and Son for the right of way for the sewer connecting Maple Ave. & Kicks Court. This to be advertised and ask for bids for the same.

Dr. Moyer brought up the proposition of building a filling station at the arch of Washington Ave. & Maple Ave. After discussion this was tabled until further notice.

The subject of the street light on High Street in front of Mrs. Fred G. Robinson property was discussed and Mayor Wilmer will look into the matter and correct same.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
