Mayor Wilmer then spoke about the Chief of Police Mr. Cooper and of his age and health and spoke of talking to Mr. Cooper and suggesting that at the first of June he be pensioned at half pay and to start in Mr. H. Hadaway in to learn under Chief Cooper, to give him any help and instrust him in his duties. After some discussion a motion was made by Mr. Rogers seconded by Mr. Wheatley that the M ayor talk with these two men and if Mr. Hadaway will consent that he find a new Special Police to take over his Saturday & Sunday night duties.

Mayor Wilmer then named Mr. James W. Crouch and Mrs. Eva Crow as auditors for the books.

The Budget was presented and Mr. Wheatley made motion seconded by Mr. Rogers that we accept same at the rate of 65¢ on \$100.00.

After some talk it was made a motion by Mr. Mr. Wheatley and seconded by Mr. Rogers that we raise the sewer rent to \$3.00 per year instead of last year rate of \$2.00. Extra stay at 25¢ each/

A letter was read from the Airport people and Mr. Rogers made a motion that we have no part in the Airport project at this time, s seconded by Mr. Moyer and Carried.

Mayor Wilmer then read his proposals for street work and the same were discussed and left for the March meeting.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
