Letters on desk from State Dept. of Health notifying the owners to connect on the new sewer.

Letter from Mr. W. Bramble in reference to the trailer camp being made on the property connecting his on Cannon Street.

Motion by Mr. Moyer that a survey be made of all the houses in town and those not connected with the sewer and if the sewer is available to require them to do so. Seconded by Mr. Wheatley and carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Wheatley and seconded by Dr. Moyer that we have a check made of the houses as to the no. of outlets. carried.

The retiring Chief Mr. Cooper brought to the office a box of odds and ends he has been saving since he took the job and left same in office. He also spoke of having some block falls, rope, chains, crow bars, etc, that he had when he came on the job and wanted to know if the Town wanted to buy same and his price would be \$25.00. A motion made by Mr. Wheatley seconded by Dr. Moyer, that the Mayor look over these things and if wanted by the Town he have the authority to buy same.

A deligation of gentlemen representing the Lions Club, Rotary Club, Business Men, and Hospital, spoke of the road leading to the Hospital and stated that the County Commissioners were willing to cooperate and meet the Town lines. Mr. Rogers stated that in a previous meeting the Town were willing to cooperate, the Clerk looked up the minutes of the meeting held in December and read same.

Mr. Howard Hadaway the Chief spoke of roberies taken place in town and suggested that we relieve Mr. Collins of his clock and keep him in the Business district more of his time than in the residential section. He only offered this as a suggestion.

Mr. Rogers spoke of the misquitos in the ditch and it was suggested that we have the town men clean out this ditch from the river on up to the Arch.

Quite an number of complaints have come in about the holes and the men are patching same.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.

Dr. Moyer spoke of a new sewer on Cabot Street from Vito Ford Lane to Dr. Murrin, this was tabled.
