This was made in motion form by Mr. Rogers seconded by Mr. Wheatley and carried.

Mr. Rogers made a motion that Mrs. Don Falls be named Supvr. and Mrs. Ernest Strong helper for the election seconded by Mr. Jones and carried.

Mr. Albert Wiggins hauled the garbage and trash for nine days at the contract price of \$5000.00.

Mayor Wilmer stated that Eliason Motors would finance this for us at the sum of \$100.00 per month with no interest.
