

September 3th, 1947.

The Mayor and Council met in regular session with the following present Mayor Wilmer, Councilmen Rogers, Jones and Fallowfield, Mr. Wheatley being absent.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved also the Clerk's Financial statement.

Mayor Wilmer reported that when the new sewer line had been laid on Front Street the old sewers had to be discontinued and the houses had to be hooked up to the new one and Mr. J. G. Klein had finished the work and submitted the bill to the amount of 250.25. The question as to the cost and Mr. Rogers made the motion that the Property Owners pay half the cost of the connections of the sewer and the Town to pay the balance, seconded by Mr. Jones and carried.

Mayor Wilmer reported that the Garbage Contract would be out October 1st. Motion made by Mr. Rogers seconded by Mr. Jones that the Mayor be authorized to advertise the garbage contract and that a special meeting be called for September 29th, to open and submit the bid.

The P. E. Church asked for a permit to place an underground oil tank on the street along side of property of the Church this tank to hold 1000 gallons this permit to be granted by a motion by Mr. Rogers seconded by Mr. Fallowfield and carried.

A letter from the Business Men's association in reference to the Building Code was read and the Mayor suggested that it be tabled.

A motion was made by Mr. Fallowfield seconded by Mr. Jones that the permit for the Recreation Hall be refused for this purpose.

Ward No. #1 Mr. Rogers spoke of filling in on the Front Street.

Ward. No. #3 Mr. Jones spoke about the complaints of Water laying on the pavements of High Street. This is to be taken care of.

Ward No. # 4. Mr. Fallowfield had no report only that they did not want the permit for the recreation Hall to be given.

The Mayor said that the time would go back on September 23th, the same time the Cities went back.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned, to meet again on September 23th, 1947.
