

**UTILITIES COMMISSION MEETING
FEBRUARY 21, 2012**

Mayor Bailey called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. In attendance were Council members James R. Gatto, Linda Kuiper, Mabel Mumford-Pautz and Mauritz Stetson, W. S. Ingersoll, Town Manager and Zoning Administrator, Jennifer Mulligan, Stenographer, and guests.

Mayor Bailey stated that cash on hand and in banks was \$893,237.92.

Mr. Sipes stated that influent diversion vault had a lighting strike in June but was now back on-line. He said that the insurance claim could now be closed.

Mr. Sipes stated that there was a teleconference with the State of Nevada about the wastewater treatment plant. He said that the performance of the wastewater treatment plant is getting Chestertown notoriety.

Mr. Sipes stated that Well 8 has been out of service for the past ten (10) years or so, but was operational and had electric working. He said that he was waiting on samples back to see if there was still contamination in the groundwater from the oil spill at the hospital many years ago.

Mr. Sipes stated that the sampler at the wastewater treatment plant was broken, but Baldwin was repairing it.

Mr. Sipes stated that there was a large expense on the bills this month and it was for a product that he had to order once every twelve (12) to fourteen (14) months, called Cleansoid.

Mr. Sipes stated that there were no complaints received about pressure or discolored water after all the water that had to be used on the fire Seventh Day Adventist Church.

Mayor Bailey asked if there were any additions or corrections to the Utilities Commission meeting of January 23, 2012. **Mrs. Mumford-Pautz moved to approve the minutes as presented, was seconded by Mr. Stetson and carried unanimously.**

There being no further business, **Mrs. Mumford-Pautz moved to pay the bills as presented, was seconded by Mr. Stetson and carried unanimously.**

Mrs. Mumford-Pautz moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:58 p.m., was seconded by Ms. Kuiper and carried unanimously.
