

**UTILITIES COMMISSION MEETING
SEPTEMBER 17, 2013**

Acting Mayor Mabel Mumford-Pautz called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. In attendance were Council members James R. Gatto, Linda Kuiper and Mauritz Stetson, Robert Sipes, Utilities Manager, Jennifer Mulligan, Stenographer, and guests.

Acting Mayor Mumford-Pautz asked if there were any additions or corrections to the Utilities Commission meeting minutes of August 19, 2013. **Mr. Stetson moved to approve the minutes as submitted, was seconded by Ms. Kuiper and carried unanimously.**

Acting Mayor Mumford-Pautz stated that cash on hand and in banks was \$1,034,233.69.

Acting Mayor Mumford-Pautz asked for a motion to pay bills. **Mr. Stetson moved to pay the bills as submitted, was seconded by Mr. Gatto and carried unanimously.**


Mr. Sipes stated that the bill for the collapsed sewer on Water Street was \$17,000.00.

Mr. Sipes stated that a house on Conley Drive was attached to a sewer line intended for future use that had not been maintained by the property owners. He said that after this was discovered, the house was tied into Conley Drive with a new connection at no cost to the homeowner.

Mr. Sipes stated that a storm line was repaired on Spring Street where there was a sinkhole. He said the collapsed terra cotta pipe was fixed and the road was repaired.

Mr. Sipes stated that there was a 911 call from the Washington Park pumping station for an alarm. He said that there was a malfunction on the generator transfer switch during a power outage that was repaired. A pumper truck was required for the night during the outage.

There being no further business, **Mr. Stetson moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:33 p.m., was seconded by Mr. Gatto and carried unanimously.**
